




Introducing: US Script's Vaccine Network

How it works:



Locate a participating pharmacy: ask your pharmacist or visit www.usscript.com/vaccines

Call the pharmacy to ensure the vaccine you need is in stock

Present your ID card to the pharmacist

Receive your vaccination

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the US Script Vaccine Network?

The US Script Vaccine Network is a benefit that allows you and your dependents to receive many commonly administered vaccines at no charge to you at most pharmacies.

How does the program work?

You can find a participating pharmacy <u>here</u>. To ensure the vaccine you want is in stock, call the pharmacy before you go. Once you are at the pharmacy, they will conduct a screening or assessment to determine if the vaccine is appropriate based on your age and overall health history. If the vaccine is appropriate, present your ID card to the pharmacist to receive the vaccine at no charge to you.

Who can get vaccinated under the US Script Vaccine Network?

Members and their dependents ages two and up may be eligible to receive age appropriate vaccines. Vaccine age restrictions vary by state. Ask your pharmacist for more information about age restrictions in your state.

What vaccines are covered under the US Script Vaccine Network?

Hepatitis A – Adult Pneumococcal

Hepatitis B – Adult Herpes Zoster (Shingles)
Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Tetanus and Diphtheria (Td)

Influenza (Flu) Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis (Tdap)

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) Varicella (Chickenpox)

Meningococcal

What about vaccines not on this list?

If you choose to receive a vaccination that that is not on this list, in stock at the pharmacy, and covered by your plan, you will be charged your standard copay for that vaccine. The pharmacy may also collect an additional fee from you for administering the vaccine.

Frequently Asked Questions Continued

How do I know what my copay is?

There are no copays for the vaccines on this list. If you choose a vaccine that is not on this list, check your ID card or with your plan sponsor to find out what your standard copays are.

Where can I find a Vaccine Network participating pharmacy?

I don't see my pharmacy on the list above. What happens if I go to a non-participating pharmacy?

If you attempt to get a vaccine at a pharmacy that isn't participating in our Network then you will have to pay full price for the vaccine and you may not be eligible for reimbursement.

Do I need to make an appointment?

No, a benefit of receiving a vaccine at a pharmacy is that you can get vaccines any time, including holidays, weekends, and evenings, without an appointment.

Can I receive the vaccine at the pharmacy's onsite clinic?

No, in order for the vaccine to be covered at no charge through US Script, it must be administered by the pharmacist. The pharmacy's onsite clinic may or may not be covered under your medical benefit.
